

CORPORATE WHEELCHAIR CHALLENGE

The Corporate Wheelchair Challenge is aimed at Western Australia's business leaders who would like to help us fundraise to continue the work we do.

We encourage you to raise as much money as you possibly can!

As a participant in the Corporate Wheelchair Challenge, you will be offered the opportunity to:

1. Have a key note presentation at your workplace by an elite athlete with a disability (ie: Paralympian / World Champion).
2. Take part in a fun wheelchair basketball game with other VIP's / business leaders in the Corporate Challenge.
3. Network with other business leaders.
4. Promote your company / business.

To join us in this exciting Challenge, there are 4 simple steps you will need to take:

1. Fill out the [Wheelchair Challenge Registration Form](#), ticking the appropriate participation level.
2. Agree to raise / donate a minimum of \$5,000 (fully tax deductible) to spend a day in a wheelchair.
3. Choose a day between 12th January 2016 and 3rd December 2016 to spend one full day in a wheelchair.
4. Encourage at least one friend, family member or work colleague to sign up to also take on the Challenge.

It is recognised that each individual is different and therefore a variety of participation options have been created to accommodate this. Some people prefer to use their networks to raise funds, whilst others are more comfortable simply making a one off donation and others like to do both! Therefore the options for taking on the Community Wheelchair Challenge are:

1. Provision of credit card details, with funds raised via Everyday Hero and balance taken from credit card, should the minimum \$5,000 fundraising not be reached.
2. Donation of \$5,000 or more upfront via credit card, cheque or EFT only.
3. Donation of \$5,000 or more upfront via credit card, cheque or EFT and also undertaking additional fundraising via Everyday Hero.
